

## The Breastfeeding Relationship Study 2022-2023

Washington State University College of Nursing is conducting a study to compare differences in the breastfeeding relationship and maternal emotions before and after mothers return to work among three groups of mothers who plan to: (1) return to work outside of the home between 6-12 weeks, (2) return to work from home (e.g., telework) between 6-12 weeks, or (3) stay home full-time with their infants.

We are seeking **breastfeeding mothers** who:

- Have started **direct breastfeeding** after childbirth
- Want to **continue to direct breastfeeding** at least once a day regardless of whether they plan to return to work or not
- Have a healthy full-term single baby
- Are 3-4 weeks postpartum
- Are currently staying at home with your baby and have not returned to work, yet
- Are older than 18 years
- Can speak, write, and read English
- Are willing to be followed up at 12, 16, and 24 weeks

Participating mothers will be asked to fill out a questionnaire. The initial questionnaire will take **15-20 minutes** to complete while the subsequent questionnaires will take 10-15 minutes.

We will send you a **\$10 Amazon gift card** after the completion of each questionnaire (**total of \$40**).
